As promised, here is the link to the MCA that has the standard language for preliminary injunctions. You could refer to this section in the rule or you could import the relevant parts. The language that was created in HB 700 in 2003 for stays of air permits is unique and creates an impossible hurdle for citizens. The language in Title 27 is standard language that applies to every other environmental law and should be used by the Department in the context of BART rules as well.
