The Board has been tracking costs associated with the standardized formats since January 2005. The costs associated with the standardized corrective action plans and reports have been analyzed in accordance with ARM 17.58.341(8) to obtain the cost ceilings. **For corrective action plans and reports not listed below, contact the DEQ PTS case manager to determine the man-hours necessary.** The first table provides the maximum reasonable reimbursement for a standard corrective action plan. The second table provides the maximum reasonable reimbursement for a standard report format. Maximum reimbursement includes all material and labor costs associated with plan and report production (copies, binding, etc).
