PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with §75-10-735(1) and (2), Montana Code Annotated (MCA), the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) hereby gives notice of a 30-day public comment period on the August 2009 Voluntary Cleanup Plan (VCP) for the Montana Department of Transportation Maintenance Facility Helena Facility in Helena, Montana. DEQ is soliciting public comment on this document. The public comment period begins on Monday August 31, 2009, and comments must be received in the DEQ office by midnight on Wednesday September 30, 2009. Copies of the VCP are available for review at the Lewis & Clark Library at 120 S. Last Chance Gulch in Helena and the DEQ Site Response Section of the Hazardous Waste Site Cleanup Bureau office located at 1100 Last Chance Gulch in Helena. An electronic version of the text, tables, figures and some appendices of the voluntary cleanup plan will be available on DEQ's website at www.deq.mt.gov/pubcom.asp. Upon written request to the DEQ on or before September 15, 2009, by 10 or more persons, a group of 10 or more persons, or by a local governing body DEQ will hold a public meeting. The VCP addresses the cleanup of the soil portion of the Montana Department of Transportation Maintenance Facility Helena Facility and provides for the placement of institutional controls to prohibit residential use or development. The Montana Department of Transportation Maintenance Facility is a nine-acre former vehicle and equipment maintenance facility located on the northwest side of the Custer Avenue and Henderson Street intersection adjacent to the Helena fairgrounds.
